# Entering the festival

#### Who can enter the Festival?

Anyone amateur performer can be entered into the festival by a Teacher, a parent or themselves if aged 18 or over.

## Can I post my completed entry form to the Entry Secretary instead of completing it online?

If you are not able to use the online system please contact the Entry Secretary who will enter online on your behalf, or send you a paper form to complete and return.

## What do I do if I'm not sure which class is right for me?

Get in touch with the Entry Secretary - they will help you.

# Parking?

There is a large council car park opposite the Town Hall. Daytime charges apply. To enter the carpark, drive for 100 yards past the Town Hall and turn left at the roundabout by the cinema.

#### What do I do if can't attend on the day?

Inform the Entry Secretary if you can't be there. This can be done by email.

#### Can I bring my own accompanist?

Yes.

#### I do not have an accompanist. What should I do?

There are two musicians who provide accompanist services for the festival. Please see the syllabus for more information. Accompanists fees are not included in the entry fee.

#### Will music stands be provided?

We have a few music stands but recommend that you bring your own, especially for larger groups, such as bands/ensembles

## Can I bring my own keyboard/compact disc player or equivalent?

Yes, we do not provide these facilities. There is a PA system in the town hall. Competitors are responsible for the technical setup.

#### How many copies of my Own Choice item will I need to bring?

Two, one for yourself and one for the Adjudicator.

#### What time should I come to the Hall?

We recommend 30 minutes before your Class is scheduled to commence.

# When will I know what day/time my Class is set?

The Entry Secretary will email entrants as soon as possible after the Closing Date and once the Programme is finalised.

## Can I bring friends and family to see me perform?

Yes, we would be delighted to welcome your friends and family to attend the festival.

## Can I take photographs during the festival?

We politely request that no photographs are taken inside the venue.

#### Is there a rehearsal space we can use prior to our performance?

Yes, there is an upstairs rehearsal space which is available. For more information please contact the Entry Secretary.

#### I still hold a trophy/cup previously awarded. What should I do?
